1. **Celebrations/Announcements-** Beth reported that her meeting with a developmental pedestrian went very well (doctor for military families). 2. **Discussion-**  
**VAC Update (Beth P)** VAC is working with the Arc of Virginia and the New Paths resources. The SEAC asked for a one-pager on Autism and a committee produced a document with facts and resources. The training for parents is being revised and funds are available to support this work. **Spanish translations will be available.**

**ACE Update (insurance and new grant) (Dawn H)** From ACE, there are 2-day training sessions for support with planning and implementing strategies. The webcast for insurance coverage for treatments (like ABA) is archived and there is a fact sheet composed for the insurance mandate. The details are coming out and finalized info will be available finally.

**Act Early Update (Deana B)** A systems change grant has been awarded in Virginia and with this funding plans are being made with a focus on early diagnosis and intervention. Deana reported that pilot programs may be set to work on capacity and sustainability for programming and data collection. Deana sent us the overview of materials from website and asked us to consider making suggestions and recommending edits and additions as we review this information.
