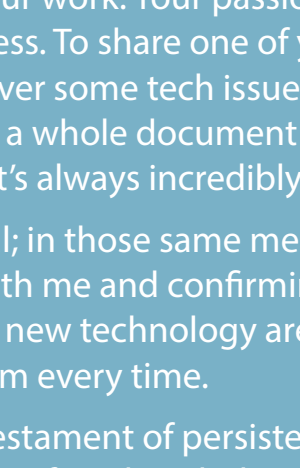




# 10 YEARS!

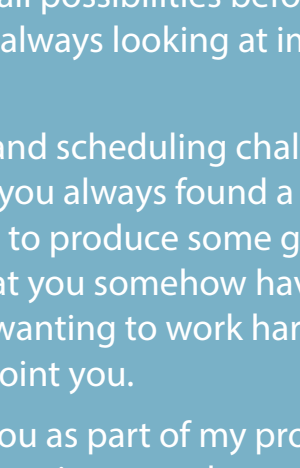

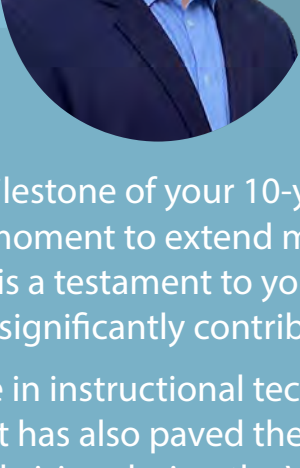

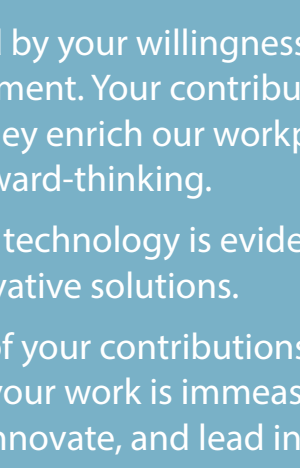


Hi Carrie,

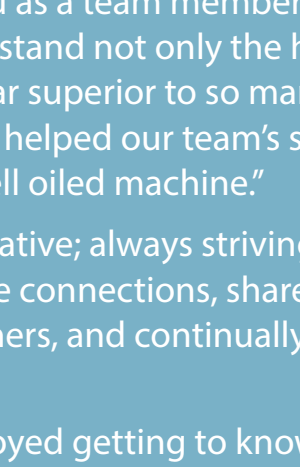
